CHILDREN’S COURTYARD GUIDELINES FOR INSCRIPTION

The Children’s Courtyard opportunity is only for individuals 21 years of age and younger. You may honor your children, grandchildren, other relatives and/or friends. Donors designating more than one listing and who would like their honorees’ names to appear together in the Courtyard must submit their registration forms and donation at the same time.

- Only One-Name entries are permitted.
Two individuals cannot be combined in the same listing.
Maximum of 36 characters on one line, including spaces and punctuation.
- No Mr. & Mrs., Mr., Mrs., etc. can be used.
- Jr., Sr., III, etc. may be used.
- English language alphabet letters only are used, with no accent marks.
- Parentheses or quotation marks are not used.
John (Jack) Smith or John “Jack” Smith will be entered as John Jack Smith.
- All listings will consist of both upper and lower case letters.
Specify upper and lower case letters where necessary (e.g. von Drake, McKay).
- No additional wording or numbers may be permitted.
Additional wording includes: birthdates, hometown, generation, etc.

HOW WILL THE NAMES APPEAR?

Each child’s name will appear on one line (36 characters maximum, including spaces and punctuation). Name placement will be determined by the date received. Inscribed characters are approximately 3/8” tall.

IS THE “CHILDREN’S COURTYARD” ONLY FOR JAPANESE AMERICAN CHILDREN?

No, the Courtyard is for all individuals 21 years of age and younger.

HOW WILL I KNOW THAT THE NAME HAS BEEN REGISTERED?

A confirmation form and acknowledgement will be sent to you by mail. You will also receive a handsome certificate personalized with the name of the child you choose to honor.

WHEN WILL THE NAME BE ENGRAVED?

Children’s Courtyard names are engraved in the summer of each year. Names received by April 30th will be engraved that year; after April 30th names will be engraved the following year.

OUTDOOR CONDITIONS

The Children’s Courtyard is located outdoors, which can make it vulnerable to damage beyond JANM’s control. JANM will make efforts to maintain the condition of the pavers but cannot be responsible for weather and use due to its public and outside nature.
