Museum COVID-19 reminders

- The Museum will extend its hours to **Tuesday-Sunday**, from **11 a.m.-5 p.m.**
- JANM Members do not need a timed ticket. Show your current membership card for free admission.
- Face masks required for all unvaccinated visitors at all times during your visit, except for children age two and younger.
- Reservations for timed tickets are required. Admission is \$16 for adults, and \$7 for seniors and students. Children are \$7; under age 5 are free.
- FREE admission every Thursday; timed ticket reservations required.
- JANM is proud to participate in the **Blue Star Museums** program with **FREE admission** for all active duty military personnel and up to five family members through Labor Day.
- No storage available. JANM cannot hold any jackets, clothing, or bags.
- You can shop the JANM Store online 24/7, but our onsite store is temporarily closed.
- The Hirasaki National Resource Center (HNRC) is temporarily closed.
