Origami Fortune Teller

Materials:

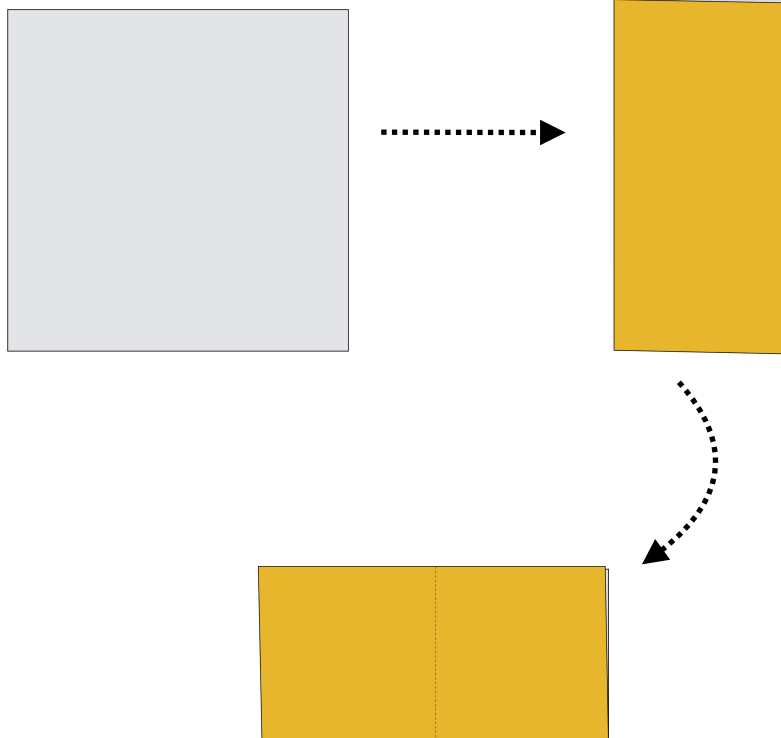
- Square sheet of paper
- pens, markers, crayons, and/or pencils to decorate!

Tips:

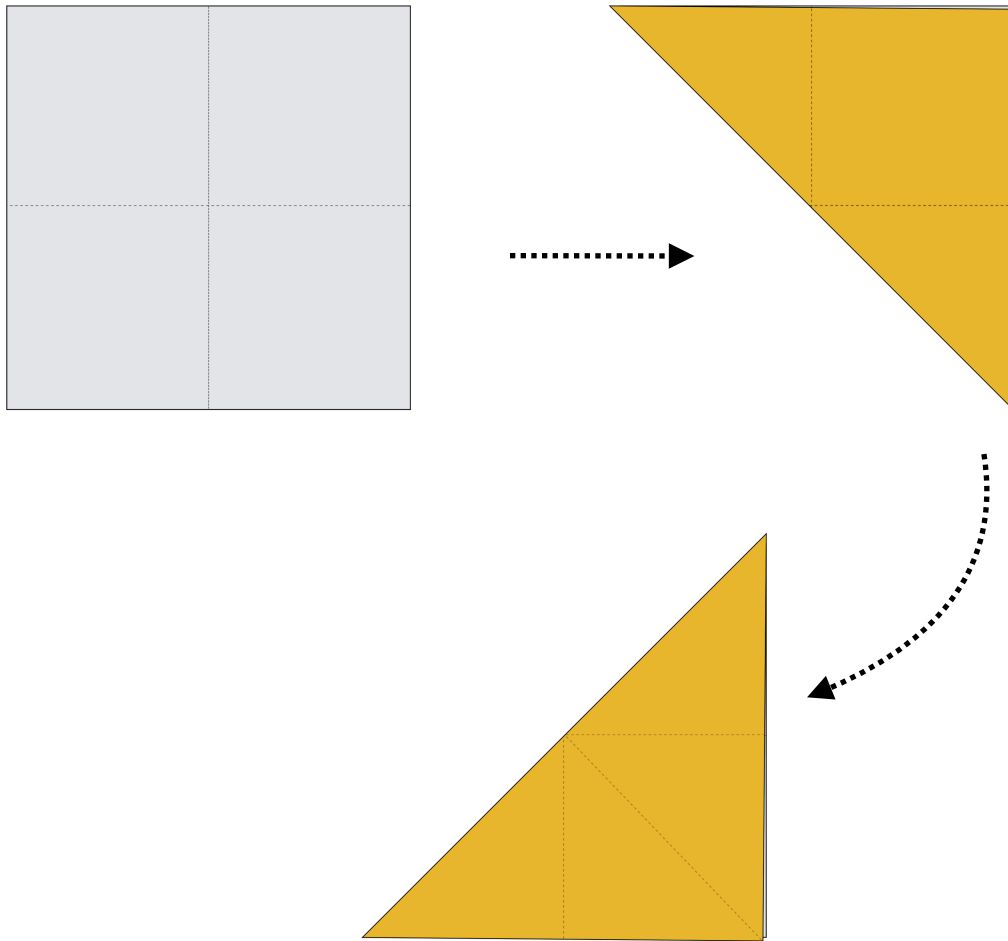
- Origami is best done on a flat surface
- Line up your edges carefully
- Make the creases as clean and sharp as you can

Instructions:

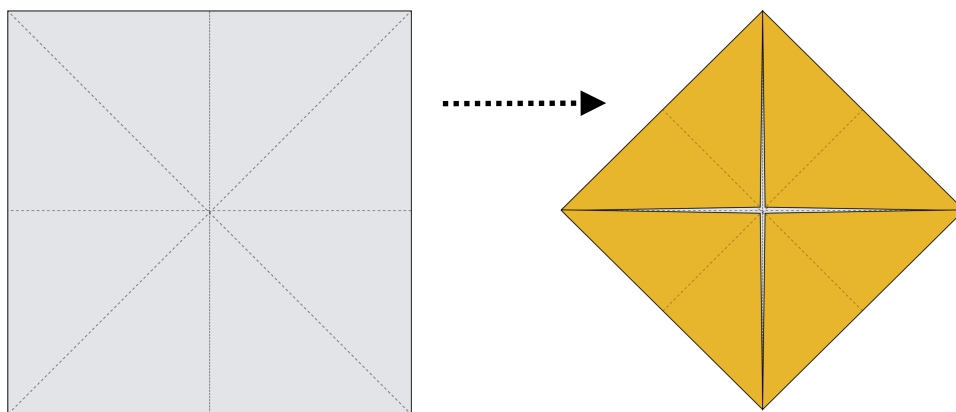
1. Choose which side of the paper you want to be on the outside of your fortune teller. With that side facing away from you, fold paper in half in both directions and unfold.



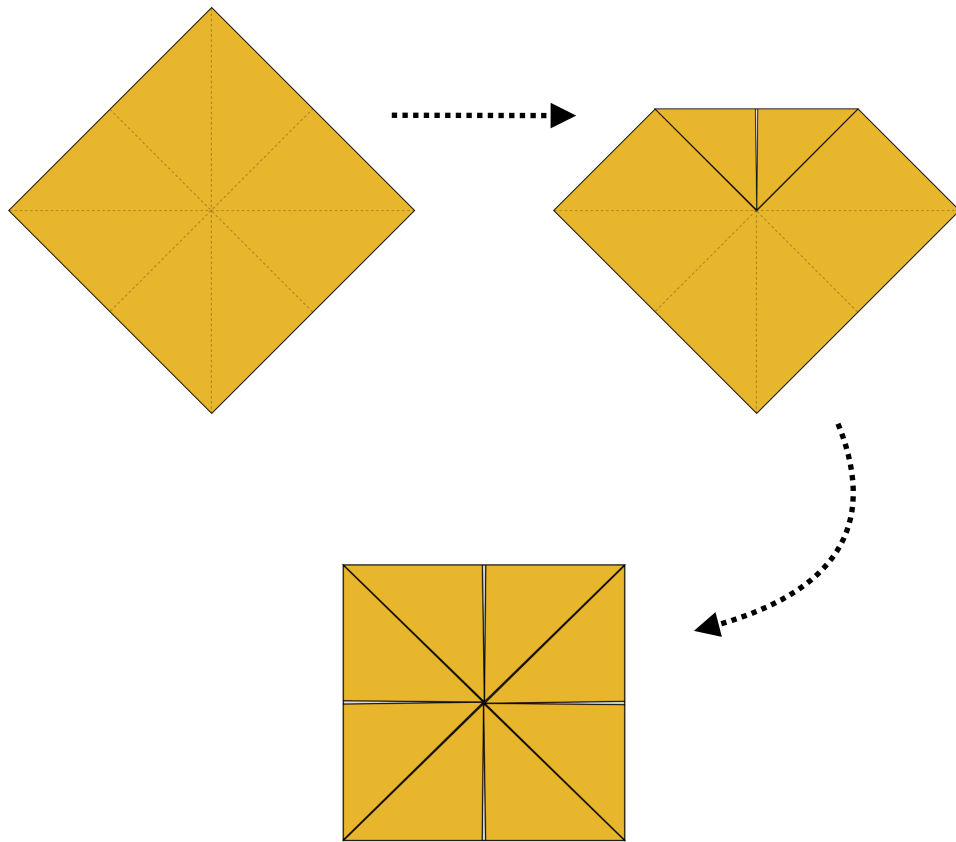
2. Fold paper in half diagonally in both directions and unfold.



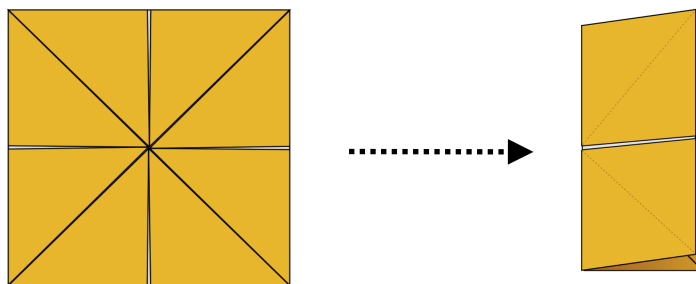
3. Fold all corners towards the center point.



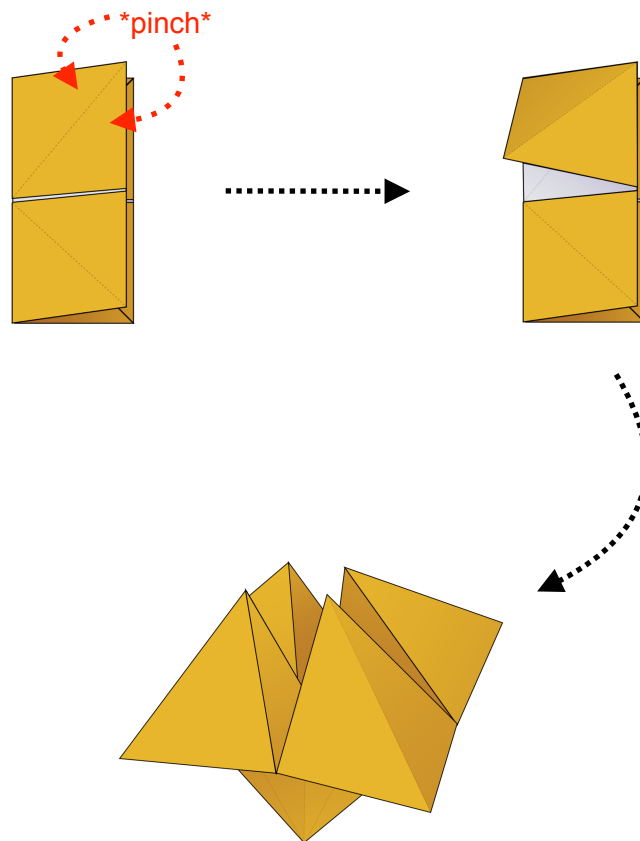
4. Flip the paper over and fold corners toward the center again to make an even smaller square.



5. Fold the square in half so that “pockets” are on the outside



6. Open pockets. This is where you can put your fingers to move the fortune teller.
Tip: gently pinch the corners to help pop them open.



7. Customize by drawing a face, or writing in fortunes!
