Tiger Face Origami

Materials:


- Square sheet of paper
- pens, markers, crayons, and/or pencils to decorate!

Tips:


- Origami is best done on a flat surface
- Line up your edges carefully
- Make the creases as clean and sharp as you can

Instructions:


1. Fold the bottom corner to meet the top corner to make a triangle.




2. Fold the triangle in half to create a crease down the middle.



3. Fold the top point down (about 1 inch); this will be the top of your tiger's head.



4. Bring the right corner up so that the fold starts at the bottom crease, and the outside edge meets the top of the head. Repeat on the left side; these are your tiger's ears.



5. Flip over and draw your tiger's face!
